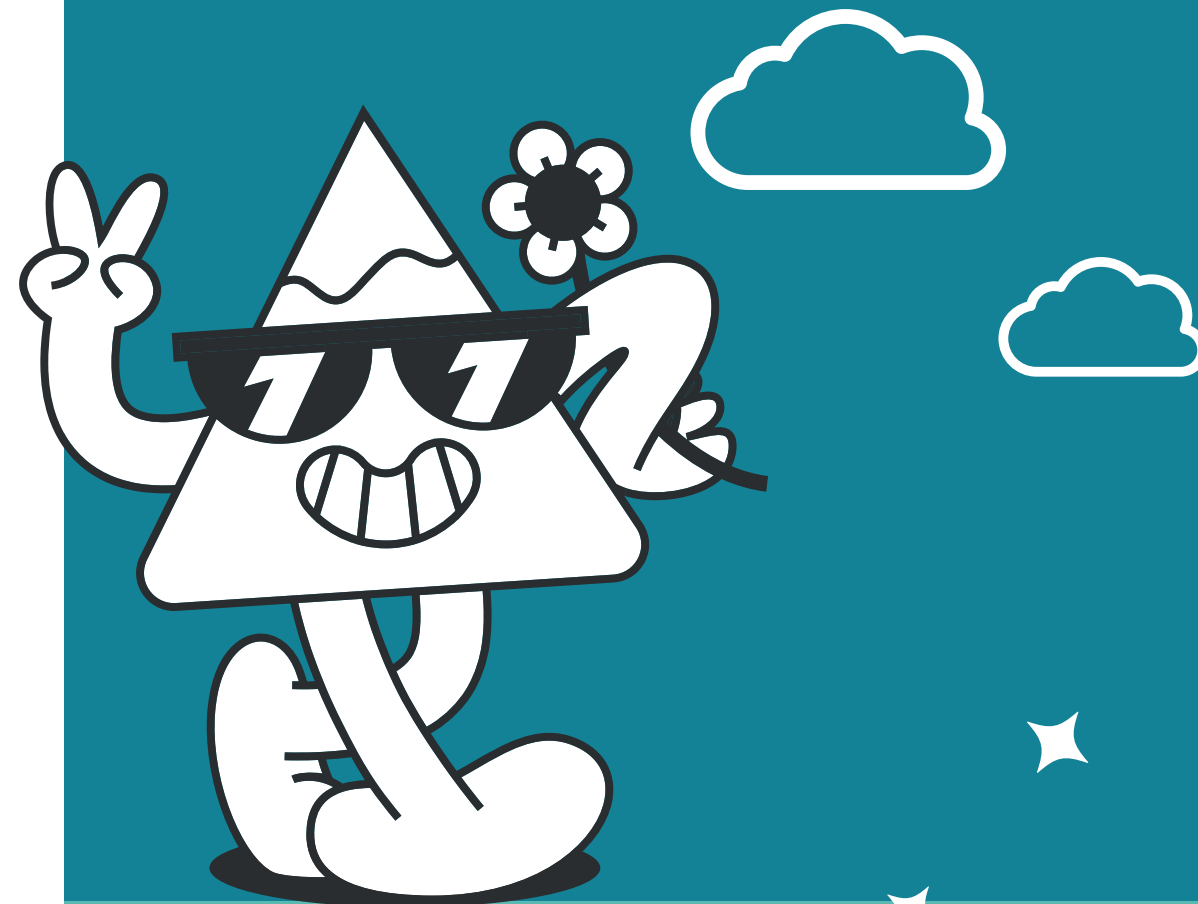


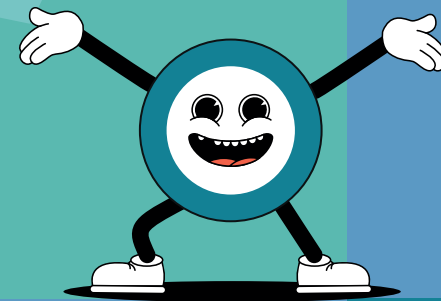

how safe do you make yourself?



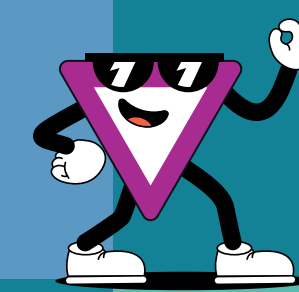

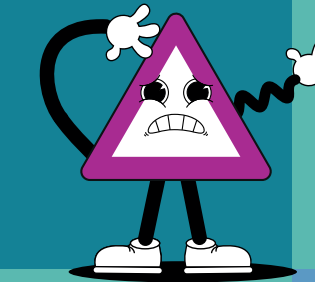
DON'T LOOK DOWN

OR, HEAD IN THE SNOW.

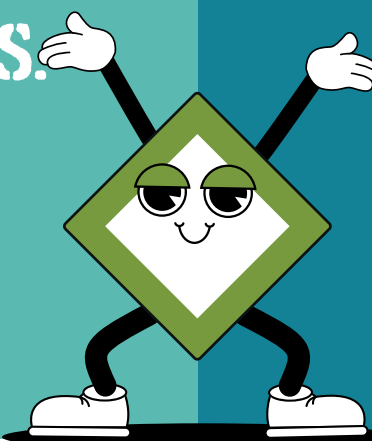
